Plumbing Leak

- 2. Please call plumber Service One at 727 944-4111. This plumber is familiar with our building, minimizing any extra damages or cost to correct the situation.
- 3. When the problem corrected please call Management to let Tim know what transpired.
- 4. If wallboard needs to be replaced due to water leak, the association is responsible for installing the wallboard. However, unit owner is responsible for covering such as paint, wallpaper, etc.

Paint Project Update

Paint project is still going with anticipation to be completed late September to early October.

- 1. The back of the building is about 95% completed. Work still being done in dockside entrance wall, knee wall and lower part of the elevator tower.
- 2. Work in the pool area has completed and front of the building has started.
